Commission XIV

The commission XIV meeting was focussed on the welding education system adopted by various countries on simulators and robotics were dealt in details. The members presented the appreciable progress made by Chinese, New Zealand, Canada and few other European countries.

Mr. Srinivasan informed the members present about the successful completion of the Audit of QCI for the IIW India Education program and the award of ISO 17024.

The Chinese welding society presented the details of the forthcoming Arc Cup competition. The organizers has requested the countries to depute the judges for the same. The judges who will be travelling to China will be given with complimentary accommodations only. All other expenses are to be borne by the individuals.

Lot of emphasis was given for Distance learning and digital learning.

WGRA meeting

In the WGRA meeting Mr. R. Srinivasan presented the IC 2017 and requested for maximum participation from the countries. He has requested the IIW secretariat to up load the first call brochure in the website. They have agreed to provide a link to the site.

AAA Meeting

In this meeting the main discussion was the new IIW

Certification program for the Inspectors were discussed. It was decided to further work on this topic and the final document and the procedure will be finalized at Shanghai in June 2017.

Young Engineers program meeting

This was attended by R. Srinivasan. He discussed and sought the permission to organize the Young Professional Conference as a parallel program during the IC 2017. The annual Assembly for the year 2018 was fixed at Istanbul. But due to the prevailing uncertain condition sat Turkey there is a possibility of the event being shifted out of Turkey. Mrs Cecile requested weather is there any possibility to shift to India if IIW India agreed. I had requested her to send an official communication IIW India for to consider the request. I personally feel this is a great opportunity

Mr. R. Srinivasan also discussed with about the new taxation rules of Govt of India on the payments made to IIW Intl. She has requested me to send the complete details for her to check up at her end. She also confirmed that there is an arrangement made with Springer who publishes the welding In the world in the similar issues.
