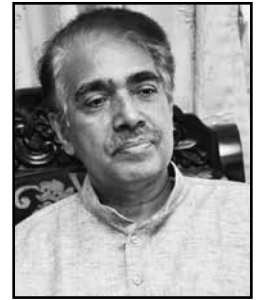


## EDITORIAL
