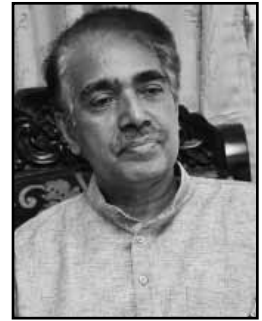


EDITORIAL
