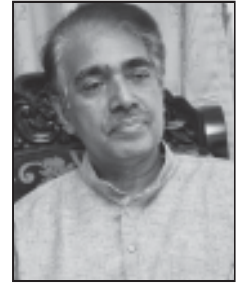


EDITORIAL
